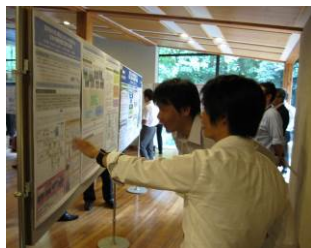
Technical Exchange

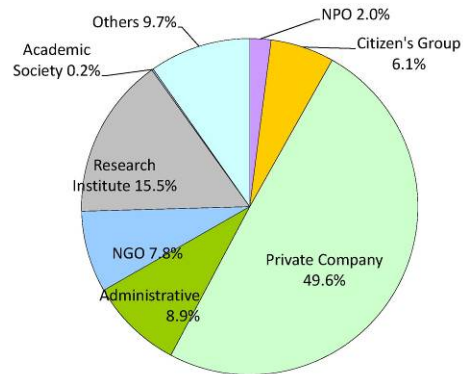


Publication

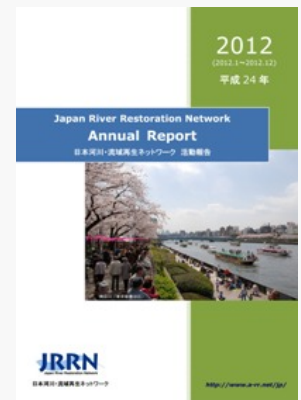
